The first NordArt took place in 1999 and is now Northern Europe's largest annual art exhibition. This year it included 250 artists from 55 countries that were juried into the exhibition. I felt honored to be one of four artists from the United States.

The exhibit opened on June 4 and was up through October 2. The location of NordArt is in the former Carlshutte Foundry and historical park at Budelsdorf, Germany, not too far from Hamburg.
